2 15-06-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Janaki Nagar P.S. Case No. 29 of 2026 registered for offences under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 352 and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioners are alleged to have assaulted the victim causing injuries.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. It is further submitted that there is a case and counter-case between the parties. It is also stated that there are injuries on the accused side as well.



5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Janaki Nagar P.S. Case No. 29 of 2026 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
