2. This application has been filed for

cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to the opposite party
no.2 by a Coordinate Bench of this Court *vide* order dated
05.03.2021 passed in Cr. Appeal (SJ) No. 661 of 2020 in
connection with Complaint Case (SC/ST) No. 48(C) of 2018
registered for the offence under Sections 147, 323, 379, 504 of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(i)(x) of SC/ST Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits

that the opposite party no.2 was granted bail on the ground that

there was a land dispute between two sides. However, the



allegations against the opposite party no.2 is that he has forcibly captured the land of the complainant who belongs to the Scheduled Castes category.

4. Upon careful consideration of the impugned order it appears that the impugned order is dated 05.03.2021 passed in Cr. Appeal (SJ) No. 661 of 2020 and more than five years have elapsed since then moreover, the learned counsel for the petitioner has not raised any sufficient ground for cancellation of bail of the petitioner. In view of the above, no ground for cancellation of bail is made out.

5. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.

6. The petitioner/prosecution is directed to co-operate in the trial so that the trial can be concluded at the earliest.
