2 15-05-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, informant
and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 89, 80, 3(5) of the
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. It is case of dowry death. Prosecution case, in brief,
is that all the F.I.R. named accused persons including this
petitioner killed the daughter of informant due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner
is brother-in-law of the deceased and he is simply victim of
over-implication. Allegation against petitioner is general and



omnibus. Petitioner is separate in mess and property and has got no concern with family affairs of the deceased. He further submits that thrust of accusation is against husband of the deceased who is already in custody since 16.06.2025. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the fact that husband of the deceased is already in custody, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Hajipur Sadar P. S. Case No. 353 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
