- 2 01-07-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.
2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 38 and 41(1) of the
Excise Act.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has antecedent of four cases out of which three
cases are under the Excise Act and is in custody since
29.03.2026 and allegation is of recovery of 112.500 litres of
liquor from a car.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession and is not the owner of
the seized car and he came to be implicated based on



confessional statement of Ram Kumar Thakur in police custody which does not have any evidentiary value.

5. Learned A.P.P. opposes the bail application.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Runnisaidpur P. S. Case No.330 of 2022.

7. The application stands allowed.
