learned counsel for the State.

2. The present application has been filed seeking
cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to Opposite Party
no. 2 vide order dated 27.01.2025 passed in Complaint Case
No. 2060 of 2023 registered under Sections 323/ 379/ 498(A)/
504/ 506/ 34 of the I.P.C. and Sections 3/ 4 of Dowry
Prohibition Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not able to
make out a case for cancellation of bail.

4. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.

5. The learned Principal District Judge, Araria is



directed to dispose of the Matrimonial Case which is pending in the court below within three months from the date of communication of a copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties. In the event of non-cooperation by any party, the learned Magistrate shall be at liberty to proceed *ex parte* in accordance with law and he shall file a compliance report in this Court after three months.
