2 16-06-2026 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioners are named in the F.I.R. and apprehending their arrest in connection with Baddi P.S. Case No. 03 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 351(2), 352, 109, 3(5) of BNS.

3. As per FIR petitioners alleged to assault informant and his mother during the course of occurrence causing bodily injuries. During the occurrence the mother of the informant becomes unconscious and was hospitalized in Sadar Hospital, Sasaram.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that present occurrence took place in



the background of land dispute. It is submitted that admittedly as per FIR, assault was made on non vital part of the body, where nature of injury found simple, negating *prima-facie* intention to cause death as alleged by petitioners. Petitioners claimed clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP opposes the prayer of bail.

6. In view of aforesaid factual submission and by taking note of fact as injury as alleged to be caused by petitioners during the occurrence found simple, negating *prima-facie* intention to cause death, accordingly all above-named petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks, are directed to be released on bail, furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned JM 1st Class, Sasaram Rohtas /concerned Court, where the case is pending in connection with Baddi P.S. Case No. 03 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS.
