3 31-07-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the learned counsel for the informant as well as the learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State.

2. At the outset, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant submits that process under Section 82 Cr.P.C. has also been initiated against the petitioners on 22.05.2026 and therefore the present anticipatory bail petition is not maintainable.

3. Accordingly, in view of the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of **Lavesh v/s State (NCT of Delhi)**, reported in (2012) 8 SCC 730, **State of M.P. v/s Pradeep Sharma**, reported in (2014) 2 SCC 17 and **Prem**



**Shankar Prasad v/s State of Bihar, reported in 2021 SCC
OnLine SC 955**, this Court is not inclined to entertain the
present anticipatory bail petition.

4. Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail
application is dismissed as not maintainable.
