2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection with Gardanibagh P.S. Case No. 152 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 112(2), 61(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023 and Section 10 of the Bihar Conduct of Examination Act.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that the petitioner has appeared twice in the recruitment examination of the Constable where he was apprehended. It is alleged that the petitioner was identified in the biometric test.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in the



present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner did not appear in the examination on behalf of any other candidate. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner had already qualified the examination twice and that the biometric machine erroneously showed him of appearing twice. He further submits that a statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is languishing in judicial custody since 21.02.2026.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Siwan in connection with Gardanibagh P.S. Case No. 152 of 2026.
