2. The present restoration petition has been filed for
restoration of C.W.J.C. No.8750 of 2022, which has been
dismissed for non-compliance of peremptory order dated
11.08.2022, passed by a learned Co-ordinate Bench of this
Court, whereby two weeks' time was allowed to the learned
