Senior Superintendent of Police, Bhagalpur along with the
report of S.H.O., Sabaur Police Station dated 18.04.2026,
wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that
the sole appellant Panchu Mandal has died.

2. In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
