3 07-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 1090 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Ara along with the Report dated 20.04.2026 of the S.H.O, Bihiya Police Station, Bhojpur, Ara, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that both the appellants, namely, Ramwati Devi and Dhunmun Lal, are dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
