learned APP for the State.

2. The present application has been filed for the
cancellation of bail granted to the Opposite Party No. 2 to 4,
vide order dated 28.04.2026 passed by the learned S.D. J.M.,
Nalanda at Bihar Sharif in connection with Complaint Case No.
1065C of 2024, registered for offence under Sections 85, 352,
351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of B.N.S. and Section 3 & 4 of Dowry
Prohibition Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the complainant was



married to one Sunil Kumar and the opposite parties no. 2 to 4 are alleged to have tortured the complainant for demand of dowry.

4. I have perused the impugned order granting bail to the opposite party nos. 2 to 4 and do not find any error in the said order. Further, the petitioner has not been able to show any good ground to interfere with impugned order granting bail to the opposite party nos. 2 to 4. Hence, no ground for cancellation of bail is made out.

5. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.
