petitioner and Mr.Humayou Ahmad Khan, learned Additional
Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
connection with Chanan P.S.Case No.13 of 2022,FIR dated
26.01.2022 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 364(A)/34 of IPC, Section 27 of the Arms Act and
Sections 16,18 and 20 of UAP Act.

3. As per FIR, this is a case of kidnapping/abduction
for ransom and said to have been done by Naxalities. They
entered into the house of Ramji Yadav and also kidnapped his
son Dharmveer Kumar and fired bullets also.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has clean antecedent. He has falsely been implicated
in the present case merely on the basis of suspicion and except



the suspicion, nothing has come during investigation against the petitioner to suggest the involvement of the petitioner in the present occurrence. Further submits that co-accused persons, namely, Manoj Kora, Mangal Koda and Reeta Devi @ Rani Devi have been granted privilege of anticipatory bail by different Coordinate Benches of this Hon'ble Court vide orders dated 27.03.2023, 21.02.2023 and 17.02.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 39977 of 2022, 62944 of 2022 and 6262 of 2026 respectively.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, petitioner has clean antecedent, name of the petitioner has been transpired during investigation on the basis of suspicion and similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted privilege of anticipatory bail by different Coordinate Benches of this Hon'ble Court, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai in connection with Chanan P.S. Case



No.13 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure/ Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023 and with other following conditions:-

(I) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(II) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(III) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his/her criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
