2 17-06-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

02. In the present case, the petitioners seek bail in connection with Manjhi P.S. Case No. 230 of 2026 registered for the alleged offences under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

03. As per prosecution case, the petitioners were apprehended carrying 10, 60 and 20 litres of illicit country made Chulai liquor, respectively.

04. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in



this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the person or possession of the petitioners and the recovery has been made from an open place and the petitioners have no concern with the said place. The mandatory provisions of search and seizure have not been followed. The petitioners are having clean antecedent and they are in custody since 04.05.2026.

05. Learned APP opposes the submission made on behalf of the petitioners.

06. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the parties and considering the period of custody of the petitioners and their clean antecedent, the petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Exclusive Special Excise Judge, Saran at Chapra/concerned Court in connection with Manjhi P.S. Case No. 230 of 2026, subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 480(3) of B.N.S.S. and also the following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioners.
- (ii) The petitioners will remain present on each and every date fixed by the



court below.

(iii) In case of absence on three consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, the bail bond of the petitioners will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
