6 08-05-2026 Perused the letter no. 350 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Jehanabad along with the report dated 01.05.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Town Police Station, Jehanabad, which indicate that the sole appellant Ram Pari Devi is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
