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| 2 | 28-07-2026 | <p>1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.</p> <p>2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 137(2) of the B.N.S., 2023.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the informant alleges that petitioner along with Surendra and Parvati Devi kidnapped her daughter on 12.05.2025, when the victim had gone out of the house at 9.30 A.M.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case by the</p> |
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informant. It is next submitted that petitioner and the victim were in love and have performed their marriage and out of the wedlock a child was born. It is further submitted that victim has not supported the case of the prosecution in her statement recorded under section 183 BNSS, as recorded in the order impugned.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Sarai P.S. Case No.119 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) B.N.S.S.
