2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in the present case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 137(2), 96 and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioner is alleged to have kidnapped the informant's daughter by enticing her away with the intention of marrying her.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner has one criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 29.01.2026. The petitioner undertakes to co-operate in the case/ trial.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer



for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Motihari, East Champaran /concerned Court below in connection with Chiraiya P.S. Case No. 436 of 2025.
