4 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 1040 dated 11.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Buxar along with the Report dated 10.05.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Buxar Muffasil Police Station, Buxar as well as the Death Certificate dated 01.06.2015 issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Dhananjay Pathak, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
