State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 111 litres of illicit liquor
was recovered from the sand stored for construction .

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
incriminating material has been recovered from conscious
possession of the petitioner. The name of the petitioner
transpired during investigation on the disclosure of Mahal
Chaukidar. Petitioner has got one criminal antecedent in which
he is on bail.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail



application .

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive special Judge Excise Court-II, Bettiah West Champaran in connection with Inarwa P. S. Case No. 68 of 2026 , subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita .
