learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The accused/petitioner is named in the FIR and apprehending his arrest in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.271 of 2025 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2022(amended).

3. Allegation against the petitioner is to engage in illegal trade/manufacturing of illicit liquor, where there is recovery of 2988 litres of IMFL/country-made liquor.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for petitioner that the seized liquor was recovered from a truck bearing Registration No. PH-10DM-8133. It is submitted that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the seizure list



appears doubtful being not supported by independent witnesses rather by police personnel. The petitioner claimed clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. In view of aforesaid factual submissions and by taking of note of fact as recovery of illicit liquor *prima facie* not appears to be made from physical possession of this petitioner, accordingly, the petitioner, above-named, who is a man of clean antecedent, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from today, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge-I, (Excise Act), Darbhanga in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.271 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the CrPC/under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
