2 10-07-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2. This modification application has been filed for modification of condition ‘(v)’ mentioned in paragraph no. 6 of the order dated 20.05.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 7380 of 2026 by this Court, whereby the petitioner was granted bail.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in view of the conditions as contained in paragraph 6 (v), the bail bonds of the petitioner were not accepted, as inadvertently in paragraph 3 of the main bail application, one criminal antecedent which the petitioner carried was inadvertently not stated.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of such a condition, despite bail being granted to him,



he could not have been released.

5. The aforesaid bail application bearing Cr. Misc. No. 7380 of 2026 was allowed with the particular condition stated therein:

“6 (v) The learned court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification”.

6. In view of such a condition, it was mandatory upon the petitioner to come out clean in stating the antecedent and as such the present application stands dismissed.

7. The petitioner is directed to move this Court afresh with a prayer for bail.
