2 30-06-2026 Without going into the merits or demerits of the case,

the present writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission

with the consent of both the Counsels.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioner submits that the petitioner has already ventilated his grievance by way of the representations dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure-P/3) and 26.11.2024 (Annexure-P/4) before the Executive Engineer, Rural Works Department, Work Division, Darbhanga-1 i.e. Respondent No. 6 herein and seeks a direction to the Respondent No. 6 to consider the same by fixing a time frame.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent-State submits that the representations given by the petitioner were way back in the year 2024 and may not be available in the office of the Executive Engineer. Learned counsel submits that in case the petitioner gives a fresh representation, the authority will consider the same in accordance with law.

4. Having regard to the above made submissions, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to make a fresh representation ventilating his grievance before the Respondent No. 6 herein as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 4 weeks from today. On such representation being given, the same shall be considered in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 4 weeks thereof. It is needless to mention that before passing any



order the petitioner shall be put on notice and given an opportunity of hearing. Any decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the party.

5. With the above directions, the present Writ Petition stands disposed of.
