4 24-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 356 dated 12.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Nalanda along with the Report dated 05.02.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Chandi Police Station, Nalanda, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Ramashish Paswan, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
