3 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 563 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Munger along with the Report dated 03.05.2026 of the Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Haveli Kharagpur Police Station as well as the Death Certificate dated 19.01.2026 issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Banwari Mandal, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
