4 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No.502 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Jamui along with the Report dated 02.05.2026 of SHO, Simultalla Police Station, Jamui as well as the Report dated 01.03.2026 of the Mukhiya, Gram Panchayat Raj, Telwa, Jhajha, Jamui, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the appellant, namely, Bajinath Singh, is dead.

In view of the said letters as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
