3 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 769 dated 02.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Banka along with the Report dated 02.05.2026 of the Additional S.H.O., Shambhuganj Police Station as well as the Report dated 02.05.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachahari, Varsabad, Block- Shambhuganj, Banka; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Udho Yadav, is dead.
