Patna as well as the Death Certificate, which was issued by the

Bihar; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light

that the sole appellant, namely, Sudharshan Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the

Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to

Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,

continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and

disposed of.
