5 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 852 dated 09.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Gopalganj along with the Report dated 01.05.2026 of the S.H.O., Barauli Police Station, Gopalganj as well as the Death Certificate dated 01.10.2023 issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Ashok Yadav, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
