APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case  
registered for the offence punishable under sections 8(c), 21(c)  
and 25 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from a car,  
altogether 280.35 grams of smack was recovered and three  
persons were also apprehended.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has  
falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel for the  
petitioner has submitted that the apprehended persons have  
disclosed that one person who was going on bike before them,



is the petitioner to whom, they were going to hand over this contraband and from where, they will distribute it and sell it. Learned counsel has further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Recovery, if any, has been made from the car which was occupied by other persons. He has been framed in this case as he is having criminal antecedent of five cases out of which, two are of similar nature. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 08.05.2026.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Araria R.S. P.S. Case No. 87 of 2026 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, NDPS Act, Araria.
