4 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 805 dated 10.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur along with the Report dated 28.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Panapur Kariyat Police Station, Muzaffarpur as well as the Certificate of Death dated 28.04.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachhari- Bakatpur, Block- Kanti, Dist.- Muzaffarpur; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Nand Lal Tiwary, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
