3 26-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 1459 dated 07.05.2026 of the

Dy. S.P., Aurangabad, along with the Report dated 02.05.2026
of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Barun Police Station,
Aurangabad as well as the Death Certificate, which was issued
by the Department of Planning and Development, Government
of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to
light that the sole appellant, namely, Janeshwar Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to

disposed of.
