State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in Panchanpur P.S.
Case No. 62 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable under
Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 22 liters illicit liquor was
recovered from the roof of the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
incriminating material has been recovered from conscious
possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no concern with
the alleged recovery and he has been made accused in this case
only on suspicion. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for
bail of the petitioner.



6. Considering the fact that the recovery has been made from the roof of the house of the petitioner, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
