ORAL ORDER

5 05-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 374 dated 26.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Munger along with the report of SHO, Muffasil Police Station Munger, dated 24.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Md.Fakhruddin, has died. Certificate of death issued by Mukhiya of Gram Panchayat Raj Mirzapur, Bardah, Block-Sadar, Munger, has also been enclosed with the said report.

In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court records be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other case.
