3 19-03-2026 Perused the Letter No.201 dated 14.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Munger along with the Report dated 14.02.2026 of Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police, Gangta Police Station, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the appellants, namely, Brahamdeo Pandit and Basudeo Pandit, are died.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
