It is needless to state that in case appropriate appeal is filed before the Secretary, Rural Works Department, Government of Bihar, Patna, within a period of one week from today, the same shall be considered on merits in accordance with law and a reasoned and speaking order shall be passed thereon, within a period of two weeks, thereafter.
