2 07-07-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with
Khawaspur P.S. Case No. 21 of 2026 registered for the offence
under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Amendment Act.

3. The recovery is of 110.04 liters of illicit liquor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the petitioners are innocent and they are in custody since
2.6.2026.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are ready to donate Rs. 25,000/- each in some



charitable organization without accepting his guilt.

6. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

7. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned Court below in connection with Khawaspur P.S. Case No. 21 of 2026.

8. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioners shall deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- each in Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Bela, Muzaffarpur and produce their respective receipts of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioners shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioners.

9. As a condition of this order, the petitioner no. 01, after being released on bail, is directed to mark his attendance at Shahpur Police Station on first and third Sunday of each month. Similarly, the petitioner no. 02 is directed to mark his attendance at Pattori Police Station on first and third Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the police station will



result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioners.
