2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the



order dated 15.02.2024 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 2816 of 2020 has not been complied with.

3. Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, submits that the show cause has been filed in this matter and in the show cause, the Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue & Land Reforms Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna has passed order dated 14.05.2024 contained in Memo No. 2147.

4. In response thereof, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners are aggrieved by the said order dated 14.05.2024, due to the reason that, misinterpretation has been made by the opposite party i.e. Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue & Land Reforms Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna
