ORAL ORDER

2 16-07-2026 Heard Mr. Prateek Tandon, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Ms. Renu Kumari, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Pakaridayal P.S. Case No. 152 of 2026 instituted for the offence
under Sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) & 317(5) of the
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. As per prosecution case, petitioner was
apprehended by the police with one stolen motorcycle.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 30.03.2026. Petitioner
bears no criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in



paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is submission of the petitioner's counsel that recovery is planted by the police party. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and nature of accusation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Pakaridayal P.S. Case No. 152 of 2026, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the



bail bonds of the petitioner.
