4 13-03-2026 Perused the Letter No. 161 dated 12.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Munger, along with Memo No. 755 of 2026 dated 08.02.2026 of the Assistant Sub-Inspector, Jamalpur Police Station, Munger, wherein it is indicated that during the enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Sonu Ram, is dead.
