4 01-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 243 dated 15.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Arrah along with the Report dated 07.02.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O, Agiaon Police Station, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Lal Babu Singh, is dead.
