4 08-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.

2. The petitioner, husband of opposite party no. 2,
apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under
Sections 341, 323, 498(A), 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner
submits that the dispute between the parties has been settled
amicably through the process of mediation and both parties have
agreed to live together, as husband and wife. Petitioner also
undertakes to keep his wife (opposite party no. 2) and children
with full respect and dignity.

4. Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 does
not dispute the aforesaid contention and confirms the fact
regarding settlement entered into between the parties.



5. Here, it is relevant to mention that earlier, with consent of the parties, the matter was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties, which has been resolved in terms of Memorandum of Agreement annexed with Mediator's report.

6. In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above-named petitioner, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs. 10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Kahalgaon (Ghogha) P.S. Case No. 147 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. / Section 482 of the B.N.S.S. with condition *that petitioner shall abide by all the terms & conditions, mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement, failing which, the learned Trial Court concerned would be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond of petitioner.*"
