per office D.O. No.390 of 1985 to the
petitioner and accordingly fix the pension of
the petitioner.*

*(b) To grant Proper amount of 3rd
ACP wherein Rs. 4800/- has been given to
the petitioner instead of Rs.5400/-*



(c) To direct the respondent authorities to release Rs. 1,54,522/- which has been adjusted from the retiral benefit of the petitioner.

(d) To pay the 18% penal interest over the entire dues payable to the petitioner.

(e) To any other relief/ reliefs which the petitioner is found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
