4 18-03-2026 The learned counsel for the opposite parties has submitted that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 28.04.2023 passed in CWJC No. 10594 of 2022, the Circle Officer, Ramgarhwa, District – East Champaran has already passed the final order under Section 6 (1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 on 07.08.2025 and thereafter the encroachment in question has also stood removed.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some encroachments are still subsisting, hence the petitioner be



granted liberty to approach the Circle Officer, Ramgarhwa, District – East Champaran for redressal of his subsisting grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
