(II) Issuance of direction/order/writ proper declaration commanding or the respondents that the non consideration of the name of the petitioner and others for promotion as per the statutory rule, without any reason, is out and out illegal, arbitrary and mala fide in the facts and the circumstances of this case.

(III) Issuance of any other direction/ directions to which the petitioner may be deemed entitled to in the facts and the circumstances of this case.”
