4 17-04-2026 Perused the Letter No.98 dated 09.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Sheikhpura along with the Report No. 164 dated 06.02.2026 of Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police, Sheikhpura Police Station as well as the report of Mukhiya, Gram Panchayat Raj Kare, Block & District- Sheikhpura, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Jarik Bind, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
