4 13-02-2026 The petitioner has filed the instant application for the following relief(s):

“i. For issuance of an appropriate writ order or direction in nature of ‘Mandamus’ directing and commanding the concern Respondents to recall the Office Notification No.2602(mu.) dated 9.6.2005 by which the allotted Quarter of the husband of the petitioner bearing Quarter No.44/84, New C.I.D Colony Shastri Nagar, Patna has been allotted to the other one without considering the facts and circumstances the position of the petitioner.

ii. For further issuance of an appropriate writ and order or direction in the nature of



'Mandamus' directing and commanding the concern respondent to stay the order of vacate the above said allotted quarter till the comply of the Hon'ble Court order Dated 21.12.2015 of C.W.J.C. No.10263/2015.

iii. For issuance of an appropriate writ and order or direction in the nature of 'Mandamus' directing and commanding the concern respondents not to disturb the helpless wife of lost employee of Govt. of Bihar, till the disposal of the claim of petitioner.

iv. For issuance of any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner found entitled to."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application.

3. In view of the above, the application is dismissed as withdrawn.
