5 22-07-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel for the State.

2. The present application has been filed seeking
cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to Opposite Party
no. 2 vide order dated 07.12.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No.
35046 of 2015 arising out of Bhojpur Mahila P.S. Case No. 100
of 2015.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that O.P.
No. 2 has failed to make monthly payment of maintenance as
directed by this Court.

4. Accordingly, the present application stands
dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the court



below, by filing an appropriate application on the aforesaid ground.

5. If such an application is filed, the same shall be considered and decided by the learned Magistrate concerned, in accordance with law, within a period of 15 days from the date of its filing, after affording an opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties. In the event of non-cooperation by any party, the learned Magistrate shall be at liberty to proceed *ex parte* in accordance with law.

6. If the learned Magistrate concerned, finds that the maintenance is not paid by O.P. No. 2, the bail bond of O.P. No. 2 shall be cancelled by him forthwith.
