with all consequential benefits, however it has been stated that payment shall be made after the funds are made available by the State Government.

2. At this juncture, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to agitate his grievances with regard to payment of the consequential benefits, by taking recourse to the due process of law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The petition stands disposed of.
