2 03-04-2026 Admittedly, the encroacher *namely* Mithilesh Kumar alias Mithilesh Sharma has filed a writ petition bearing CWJC No. 14501 of 2022 and a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court *vide* order dated 14.10.2022 has directed to maintain *status quo qua* the land/house of the said writ petitioner, hence it is submitted by the learned counsel for the opposite parties that the Circle Officer, Jehanabad by an order dated 28.10.2022, passed in Encroachment Case No. 25 of 19-20 has directed to maintain



status quo.

2. In view of the aforesaid, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to intervene in the said writ petition bearing CWJC No. 14501 of 2022, however submits that in case the aforesaid writ petition is dismissed, the petitioner be granted liberty to revive the present contempt petition.

3. Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands disposed of, however with liberty to the petitioner to revive the present contempt petition in case the aforesaid writ petition bearing CWJC No. 14501 of 2022 is dismissed.
