A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Amour P.S. Case No. 32 of 2000 instituted under Sections 363, 366A and 120B of the I.P.C.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioner and others are accused of kidnapping the victim and then selling her for Rs. 14,000/- to Rampal Yadav and Sarvesh Yadav.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is involved in human trafficking and the petitioner is



also trying to tamper with the evidence of the case.

6. Considering the gravity of offence, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

7. Accordingly, the application stands dismissed.

8. The petitioner is directed to surrender within two weeks from today and pray for regular bail, failing which the Superintendent of Police, Purnea will take all steps for arrest of the petitioner.

9. The Superintendent of Police, Purnea is directed to see to it that the victim girl is recovered so that her statement is recorded in the court below and file a compliance report within eight weeks.
